

Kathy Page receives Clerk of the Year Award

The 2008-2009 7th Judicial District Superior Court Clerk of the Year Award was presented to Kathy Page, Clerk of Superior Court of Dade County during ceremonies on April 22, 2009. The 7th Judicial District consists of 14 counties which include Bartow, Catoosa, Chattooga, Cobb, Dade, Douglas, Floyd, Gordon, Haralson, Murray, Paulding, Polk, Walker and Whitfield. The awards banquet was held in conjunction with the Superior Court Clerks' Association of Georgia's spring mandatory training session from April 20th thru April 23rd, 2009 on St. Simons Island.

The conference which provided nineteen and one-half hours of training was sponsored by the Superior Court Clerks' Training Council and the Georgia Institute of Continuing Judicial Education. Training for Superior Court Clerks covered E-Notary Filing, Adoptions, and Georgia Applicant Processing Service. Roundtable discussions included questions and answers relating to Liens, Fi Fas, Garnishments, Department of Corrections Website, Department of Driver Services, Georgia Electronic Conviction Processing System, E-mail Etiquette, Jury, Juvenile, and IT Contracts and Data Security. The Georgia Superior Court Clerks Cooperative Authority reported on support issues and future training. Current and new legislation affecting Superior Court Clerks and the courts was presented.

Six hours of training was dedicated to the Superior Court Clerks' Certificate Program. All clerks are given the opportunity to participate in this program specifically designed for Superior Court Clerks. The seventy-two hour course consists of specialized curriculum planned by the Carl Vinson Institute of Government and the Superior Court Clerks' Training Council. After completing the requirements of the program, the certified clerk must attend a six hour up-date course annually to maintain the certificate.

The continuing judicial education training gives Superior Court Clerks an opportunity to stay informed of any changes that affect their offices as well as other valuable legal, technological and office management techniques. The training is focused directly on the duties of the clerk's office that enable the clerks to better serve the citizens of their counties.
